They can be what they want to be in life as long as they are not deprived of their basic right such as education and skills. Every child can give value to the society irrespective of their background and/or disability.



The main goal for us is to make every child self-reliant through education and skill empowerment. When they are independent, they become creative; they make relationships, create or get resources and thus reduce poverty. After being independent, they can contribute

their own quota to the society. To achieve this, their mindset is a priority and thats why we must make sure they have access to education to create a sense of purpose and

belonging.

At Raising Star Africa, we believe in the dream of every child. The dream of every child is valid irrespective of their disability. The power to dream and to achieve this dream, sums up the reason for our existence at Raising Star Africa.

#### **SUPPORT INCLUSIVE SCHOOL INITIATIVE**

This is one of our core programs at Raising Star Afirca where we make education accessible to every child. We promote inclusion by renovating dilapidated school buildings and other education interventions that make learning and a positive classroom environment accessible to all. This year, we renovated an inclusive school in Igando. This way fully funded by BIC Multinationals.

## LOCAL GOVERNMENT PRIMARY INCLUSIVE SCHOOL



This is an inclusive school located in Igando, Alimosho in Lagos State. The school has over 700 children with 3 blocks of classroom. We renovated the block for children with disabilities which has 3 classrooms. The holistic renovation was sponsored by BIC multinationals. We had the BIC team visited three times and they carried out their education week in the school

## VOCATIONAL AND SKILL SUFFICIENCY TRAININGS



We trained 40 students at Oki inclusive schools with hairdressing, shoe making and tailoring skills. They made footwears which generates income for both the schools and the students, thus reducing poverty.







## GETTING OUT-OF-SCHOOL CHILDREN BACK TO SCHOOL

Every child must have access to education irrespective of the background or disability.

 Rachael whose parents has given up on her because she is intellectually challenged, was gotten back to an inclusive school. Currently, Rachael is described by her teacher as the most active student. We got 80 children with or without disabilities back to school.



 3 children of a mother whose husband suffered from a stroke were sent back to school with their school fees fully paid.



 Victor, a boy whose parents are both blind, was gotten back to school and retained. Victor is now in KG 2. He is on our permanent scholarship.



### STARS OUT INITIATIVE

This is the program that facilitates exposure, life and social skills of children with disabilities. We took children with disabilities in 3 primary inclusive to City Malls and National Museum. A total of 97 children with disabilities were taken outside the four-walls of the classroom. In Shoprite, the children did shoppings to increase their life skills and sense of belonging. In the museum, the children were sensitized about Nigeria's historical background and they really had fun.

## PROVISION OF EDUCATIONAL MATERIALS

To foster learning, we donate basic and educational materials to children. Through this program, we donated basic and educational materials to 255 students in 4 schools in Lagos and Ogun state, Nigeria. One of the donations was fully funded by BIC multinationals.

Donation of 270 exercise books and other writing materials with disabilities at Igando inclusive schools.









### **OUR COLLARBORATIONS**



We collarborated with Toyin FSanni foundation to provide a school bus which conveys 30 students with disabilities to and fro school. This has relieved the parents of the stress and logistics expenses involved in taking the children to and fro school.

### **BACI**

We partnered with BACI to organise her annual conference for 130 secondary school students in ogun state to imbibe character, mental wellness and prevent drug abuse amongst teenagers.

### **GHEI**

We collarborated with GHEI to provide sanitary pads to over 30 girls with disabilities in Oki inclusive schools to increase menstrual hygiene education among girls with disabilities.





## DISABILITY AWARENESS EVENTS THIS ABILITY

- This is an annual event that sheds spotlight on thetalents and skills of children with disabilities. It create awareness about the talents that are embedded in children with disabilities. It informs the society about abilities in disabilities to reduce stigmatization and marginalization in the society.
- The event is used to commemorate children's day celebration on May 27th. 4 schools took part in this event namely- Oki inclusive schools, Olisa, RCM and Igando inclusive schools. 120 students and 10 teachers took part in the event. The children were awarded a cash prize from the 1st position to the 4th position. The 1st position from Olisa schools won 100,000 naira and the 4th position from RCM primary inclusive school won 20,000.
- The students sold the materials they made during the skill exhibition and made more money for themselves. In the event, we had guests from Abuja, an actress from the USA (Diamond Sonpon), the former Deputy Governor of Lagos state (Sarah Sosan) and the present Senior Special Assistant to Lagos state Government on Disability (Adenike Oyetunde).







### SPORT FEST

This is our annual sporting event which is done to commemorate the International Day of Persons with Disabilities. The event took place on December 3rd at Igando Inclusive schools. 4 schools participated namely-Igando inclusive schools, Oore Ofe, Oki and Olisa inclusive schools. Atotal of 80 students, 15 teachers and 6 sports officials participated. We created each house with a disability term namely Ability house, Independent, Inclusion and Special House. The children participated in relay races, fill-in-the-bottle, sack races, table tennis and so on. The Ability house came first and Bukola Boderin from Igando Inclusive schools was awarded the overall best student with a cash price of 50,000 nairs. We had a special guest appearance of His Royal Majesty, Ooni of Ife. This event highlights the abilities in children with disabilities and showcased their sporting talents. This created awareness about persons livinf with disabilities and their special abilities thus reducing stigmatization in the society.









### OUR END OF THE YEAR PARTIES

We did chiristmas patries in two schools- Oore Ofe and Roman Catholic Mission (R.C.M) Inclusive Schools.
Oore Ofe inclusive school party was fully funded by the Toyin F Sanni Foundation and the RCM Christmas party was funded by individual donations.


